**The Result?** As you admit your sin, ask Jesus Christ to have a permanent place in your heart and take Him forever as your Savior:

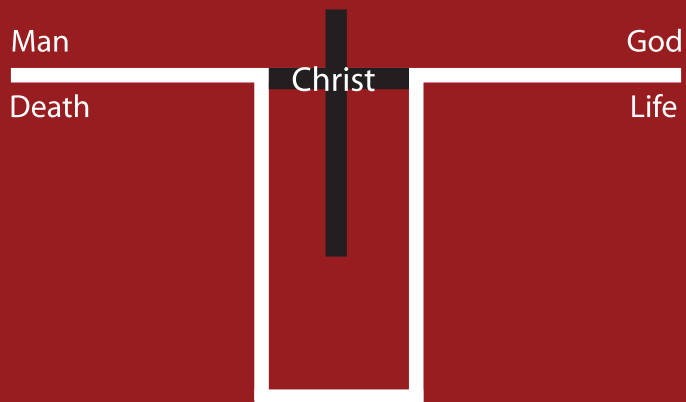
